I have just heard that Mr. Eugene Fodor, who started Fodor's Guides wishes to stand up and make a statement in which he will tell the world, as well as Mr. Hersh of the New York Times, that he is proud of the service that he was able to render to the CIA and to his country by his association with the Guides. Some people have tried to talk him out of it but he appears determined to go ahead. He is at his home in Connecticut.

Fodor's connections with the CLA have long been known. However, if he now draws attention to them at this sensitive time, there is a danger that the attendant publicity might
