SUBJECT: DOD Message on Greek Requests for Military Equipment

You asked for a cable to Secretary Kissinger outlining the major Greek requests for military equipment in SecDef 261457Z (Tab B).

SecDef message 261457Z Feb 75 is a long and very detailed listing of 141 separate requests of the Greek government for military equipment. It covers Hellenic Army, Navy, and Air Force wants, and gives the status of each request, along with price and availability information.

At Tab A is an overview of the DOD message, citing the major items of equipment requested by the Greeks. This will probably answer the basic questions of the Secretary about the list, but to answer any questions of detail I suggest having the DOD message repeated to the Secretary's party. Tab A provides for this.

RECOMMENDATION

That you approve the overview message to the Secretary at Tab A and also direct that the SecDef message of Tab B be repeated to the Secretary to answer questions of detail.

SUBJECT: GREEK REQUESTS FOR MILITARY EQUIPMENT

1. SECDEF 261457Z FEB 75 IS A NINE PAGE MESSAGE WHICH LISTS IN GREAT DETAIL 141 SEPARATE REQUESTS OF GREEK ARMED FORCES FOR EQUIPMENT, AND GIVES PRICE AND AVAILABILITY FOR EACH. MESSAGE NOTES THAT NEITHER STATE NOR DOD APPROVAL HAS BEEN GIVEN FOR SALE.

2. GREEK REQUESTS, WHICH HAVE NOT BEEN RANKED BY PRIORITY OR RELATED TO FINANCIAL RESOURCES, TOTAL \$310 MILLION FOR GREEK AIR FORCE, \$240 MILLION FOR GREEK NAVY AND \$234 MILLION FOR GREEK ARMY. MAJOR ITEMS INCLUDE:

A. FOR THE AIR FORCE: UH-1H AND SH-3 HELICOPTERS;  
F-4E'S AND RF-4E'S; OV-10 ARTILLERY CONTROLLER AIRCRAFT;  
MOBILE RADARS; ECM EQUIPMENT; SPARROW AND AIM-9J AIR  
TO AIR MISSILES; AIR-TO-GROUND MUNITIONS LIKE MAVERICK,  
HOBOT KITS FOR BOMBS, ROCKEYE CBU'S, ZUNI ROCKETS, SHRIKES;  
AND VULCAN AUTOMATIC CANNON FOR AIR BASE DEFENSE.

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B. FOR THE NAVY: POINT DEFENSE MISSILE SYSTEM; ANTI-SHIP MISSILES; TORPEDOES; CHAPPARAL; SUB-LAUNCHED HARPOON MISSILE; VARIOUS RADARS; CRYPTO GEAR; PATROL BOATS AND A DESTROYER;

C. FOR THE ARMY: VARIOUS TACTICAL RADIOS; UH-1H AND OH-58 HELICOPTERS; 155 MM AND 105 MM HOWITZERS; TRUCKS AND TANKS; BRIDGING EQUIPMENT; ARMORED PERSONNEL CARRIERS; TOW ANTI-TANK MISSILES; HAMLET ANTI-AIRCRAFT MISSILE (DANISH MODIFICATION OF REDEYE); AND MINEFIELD CLEARING EQUIPMENT.

3. GENERALLY SPEAKING, THE NUMBERS WHICH HAVE BEEN REQUESTED IN EACH CASE ARE MODERATE, VIZ. 12 F-4E'S AND 130 ARMORED PERSONNEL CARRIERS. HOWEVER, THE LIST REPRESENTS A POTENTIAL INCREASE OF GREAT IMPORTANCE IN THE SOPHISTICATION AND NUMBERS OF THE WEAPONS IN THE GREEK INVENTORY. ALTHOUGH SOME OF THE ITEMS ON THE LIST HAVE ALREADY BEEN APPROVED FOR SALE BY THE USG, THE LIST AS A WHOLE COULD CLEARLY BE USED IN NEGOTIATIONS WITH GREECE OVER BASE FACILITIES AND RESTORATION OF THE GREEK ROLE IN NATO.

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4. ABOVE PROVIDES OVERVIEW OF GREEK REQUESTS BUT I AM  
HAVING THE DOD MESSAGE REPEATED TO YOU TO ANSWER ANY  
QUESTIONS OF DETAIL.

COMMENTS ON AVAILABILITY, ESTIMATED DOLLAR COSTS AND SPECIAL REMARKS WHICH FOLLOW ARE KEYED TO EQUIPMENT ITEMS IN SEQUENCE PRESENTED IN REFERENCES A, B AND C.
