2	Ops Br Int'l Div	7821 Comp Group	17 Sept 48	<p>1. A check with the Combined Travel Board and files of this headquarters has revealed that LOCHNER is not blacklisted by U.S. authorities.</p> <p>2. It is possible that LOCHNER has been placed on some sort of Turkish blacklist and is being denied a visa for that reason. If this is true it would be extremely hazardous to send him to Turkey, even under an alias, since he is evidently known there.</p> <p>3. Since it would be necessary to have the U.S. State Department take up this case with the Turkish Foreign Office to have LOCHNER removed from a Turkish blacklist, it is felt that LOCHNER would be completely compromised before his arrival in Turkey. It is, therefore, felt that if LOCHNER is on a Turkish blacklist he should not be sent there on a mission for U.S. Intelligence.</p>
