1. The following information on the subject appears in a BR-Land primary intelligence report from CF-Land. The source was the BR-Land CF-Land War Office contact.

2. According to the source's informant, ~~Sipow~~ is a subsection of Danzig as far as the Sipo and S.S. is concerned.

3. "Gestapo" officers in Danzig

Cel
(a) Sturmabfuhrer LODGEN. Head of the "Gestapo" in Danzig. Born at Aachen. Worked for the Germans in Poland both before and during the German occupation. A keen Nazi. Description: Height about 1.75 m. Age about 47. Strongly built and rather fat. Pale face, straight nose, blue-grey eyes. Hair thin and parted in the middle. Wears gold-rimmed spectacles. Well shaven. Numerous gold fillings in his teeth. Married with two children (twins, boy and girl, aged about 10). Lives at Zoppot.

Cel
(b) Kriminalinspizor Otto SOHNACK. Assistant to LODGEN at Danzig. Used to work for the Germans at Saarbrucken. Not a member of the Nazi Party, and on reliable authority is known to have been compelled to join the S.S. because of his knowledge of Russian and conditions in Russia, father German, mother Russian.
