1. The Subject, who is also [] mother-in-law, is now in Munich attempting to immigrate to the United States. We understand from [] that the eligibility of the Subject has been questioned by the Immigration and Naturalization authorities in Germany on the grounds that she has already emigrated under IHO provisions to England and therefore is not entitled to emigrate from Germany a second time under the existing regulations.

2. Since the Subject's presence in Germany results in a morale problem for both GASSOWARY k and [] we are ready to use non-official persuasion in order to see to it that she is allowed to come to America. If, through local liaison channels in Munich, it is possible to persuade the Immigration and/or IHO people to renew the Subject's eligibility, then no action will be taken here in Washington. On the other hand, once all possibilities of non-official persuasion have been exhausted in Munich without success, Headquarters will apply officially in Washington to the proper office to have new instructions on the Subject's case issued to the Munich office which is delaying her travel.

3. Please report on what can or cannot be done in Munich to aid this relative of our two operational friends. To the best of [] knowledge, his mother-in-law would have no difficulty had she not previously gone to England. If you are unsuccessful in Munich please tell us which office in Munich is responsible for holding up the necessary action, so that we can determine where to initiate action here.
