0845 Picked up George and Charles in Arlington.
0945 Arrived Stainton place. Informed [] that this would be our
last day.
1000 Reviewed Friday's reading assignment with George and Charles.
Answered their questions regarding same. Assigned remainder of
reading assignment sent out Thursday, by Gus.
1005 Took [] to market. Had George and Charles lock up and instructed
them to remain out of sight and not to answer the door or phone.
1045 Returned from market.
1155 Secured for lunch and recreation.
1300 Commenced studies. Reviewed entire course from notes taken by
George and Charles.
1500 Secured from studies.
1530 Departed for D. C. with George and Charles.
1615 George and Charles disembarked in Arlington.

Tuesday, 27 October 1953

0800 Picked up George and Charles.
0900 Arrived Stainton place.
0950 Arrived with [] (last instructor).
1000 [] departed, [] commenced instructions.
1155 Secured for lunch and recreation.
1300 Commenced lectures and instructions.
1500 Secured from lectures. [] departed.
1530 Double checked premises for material left behind, bid adieu to
George and [] and departed for D. C.
1615 George and Charles disembarked in Arlington.
