#### BACKIRCUMD INFORMATION

- 1. Subject was afforded a polygraph interview on 29 November 1960 at a covert location in Washington, D.C., between the hours of 1330 and 1600 at the request of the case officer, was conducted in the English language.
- 2. The purpose of the interview was to assist in the establishment of Subject's born fides and to detarmine any connections, past or present, with any foreign intelligence services. Subject has been employed by American Intelligence agencies since 1947.
- 3. Subject was born on 4 December 1906 in Tarnopol, Foland. He is a graduate from Gymnasium. From 1933 until 1939, Subject studied medicine at the University of Montpeliers, France, and the University of Vianne, Austria. In October 1939, Subject returned to Poland and lived in Krakow with his relatives until April 1940. In April 1941 is Subject joined the Unrainian-German Battalion with the rank of first ligutement and resained in the Battalion until Howester 1941, when he was demobilized. He then went to Berlin where he was a fire warden until January 1943. From January 1943 to April 1943 he studied medicine at the University of Berlin. On 23 April 1943, Subject was arrested by the Germans on suspicion of belonging to ODS and was sent to Sachsenhausen Concentration Cusp where he remained until Catcher 1944. It is to be noted that Subject was a member of CUS, however, he was not active and did not have any credentials to substantiate his nembership. Subject Joined CUS in 1937 while studying in Vienna. In Groober 1944, when released from the Concentration Cusp, he went to Krakow, Foland, where he studied until December 1944.
- 4. While in Eyahow, Subject established contact with UFA through Doctor John Hammicom (MR/IM). On 27 December 1944 Subject parachuted from a Germai plane for UFA into the vicinity of Kalues, West Ukraine, and resained there until Movember 1945, during which time he engaged in underground activities. In Howember 1945, Subject came to Munich.

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From 1945 until 1952, Subject and Doctor John HRENICCH were empaged in lisison work with the allies for the purpose of promoting the Ukrainian cause. Subject came to the United States in 1952. Subject was promoted to lieutenant colonel in UPA after his arrival to Munich.

- 1. Subject has two first cousies residing in the Lvov, Western Ukraine, Roman BACZYMHKI (MR/IMD), who is an Outhodox priest, and Daria BOLINGOWICZ nee BACZYMHA (MR/IMD). Subject believes that Daria is living with Rossn at the present time. Subject also has a paternal uncle, FRU LOPATIESKI (ER/IND), who lived in Kosov and, if he is alive, he would be approximately 30 years of age. Subject stated he does not correspond with any of his relatives who reside behind the Iron Curtain.
- 2. Subject stated that he personally never had any contact with any Communist Intelligence service, however, Subject's UFA unit had some local uniorstanding between the UPA unit and the Soviet military forces.
- 3. Subject did have personal contact in 1945, when he was a seaber of a mission which contacted Polish Auti-Communist Organization, AK-Will, for the purpose of making local arrangements beneficial to both groups. Subject claims that he had participated in three (3) such conferences, each lasted approximately three or fear hours.
- 4. During 1945-1946, Subject, as a representative of UFA, was in personal contact with French Intelligence in Immebruck, Austria.
- 5. Subject, at the present time, is a number of UPA. He belongs to the UPA chapter in New York City. He pays dues and is active in UPA activities. Subject claims that he does not hold any elective office in this organization.
- 6. Subject stated that his wife is cognizant of the fact that he is employed by the U.S. Government, however, Subject stated that she does not know any specific facts about the employment.
