- Aug/52 Subject apparently was guilty of improper conduct in connection with aircraft flights to Berlin. Subject (under Gerd BOLDT alias) was allegedly completely in the wrong. (Subject attempted secure passage for the daughter of one of his agents from W. Berlin to W. Germany without going through the proper channels and was reprimanded).
- Nov/52 Subject, under alias (Otto KRUSE), was arrested for traveling on an expired MT, on Nov 52. Through KUBARK-RENTHE efforts subject was given a new MT and allowed to proceed in his way.
- Aug/53 Otto MEYER, V-1245.27, was an agent run by Subject who disappeared and was presumably arrested while on a mission. MEYER was Subject's chief once in Munich, and Subject allegedly warned MEYER not to mention to the "entire" that MEYER had had radio experience as he might lose him.
- Jan/54 During late January, 1954 Munich FO (political police) attempted to contact Subject through GDI Munich. GDI told us and so told "REXING" to get in touch with FO which they did. FO wanted to check out the story of a former agent of "LUSTIG", one working "MISERY", born a Jan 51.
- Nov/57 LIT is in state of shock on Subject in false name after learning that his neighbors had been questioning regarding persons representing themselves as LIT agents. LIT was investigating the incident. He replied - "No traces available for passing."
