SUBJECT: Alois LUX

1. Reference is made to your communication, File No. A 8 608 229 (INV-1W), dated 18 March, 1955.

2. Microfilmed cards of SHAEF/Bremen showing SS personnel in Germany as of 30 January 1944 gave the following description of Alois LUX, possibly identifiable with Subject:

SS No. 139977, SS Obersturmfuehrer der Reserve, 7th SS Volunteer Mountain Division, 'PRINZ EUGEN'.

3. Our files also revealed the following information, possibly identifiable with Subject's wife:

Microfilmed cards of SHAEF/Bremen, dated May 1943, list an Emma WAGNER as a Gestapo employee in Abteilung IV 3 a, München.
