A WHO'S WHO OF ALBANIAN GUERRILLAS

Complete list of the principal known guerrilla leaders.

The subjoined list shows names of units and their appearance, political alignment, their present or predominant roles or affiliation, approximate number of men, and the locality in which each territorial group is located.

The following should be noted in making political adjustment of guerrilla forces:

A. - C. - The so-called "partisan" units of the Yugoslav National Liberation Army, members of which have merged with the Partisans and others of N.O. units, should be absorbed into the regular人民解放军. This procedure, however, may, from the Yugoslav point of view, be necessary to prevent T.N.C. forces.

B. - D. - Remnants of Yugoslav National Guards, former members of the Partisans, should probably be read in battle readiness to Government, if they do not prove willing to integrate.

B. - E. - National Guard (Slobodna Armija) units, conservative and collaborationist, are the most dangerous collaborators with Germans, and the most treacherous against the Partisans. They are, however, unreliable and corrupt.

E. - F. - Zogists. Organized primarily in the north. This group is a loose amalgamation composed of remnants of the royal army who fled to Albania. It follows a watch and wait policy, while some elements are actively collaborating with the Germans. It has close ties with the German Government and the Ballists.

I. - G. - Independent. Groups refusing to take sides or those whose political alignment is doubtful. (Usually Bejrakts in the North of Albania who operate with their own groups.)

IRR. - Irredentists. Groups in "no-go" and liberated regions, who are intensely nationalistic and want to be included under the Albanian Government. Most of them collaborate with the Germans and are hostile to Tito's forces, to Mihailovic, and to Yugoslav Communists, as none offer hope of escape from Yugoslav domination.

21. BICAKU, Aziz	Unknown	ELBANIAN (Fosnenje)

Party: BK and collaborates with the Germans.

Remarks: He always seems to work with Germans. He is the man who captured Brigadier General Darios (and turned him over to the Germans) on Jan. 8, 1944. A Jan. 14, 1944 report claims that Feza (No. 20), in retreat from the Germans, was attacked by Bicaku near Vjti.

22. LUJO, Skender	Unknown	VALONA

Party: An important BK figure.

Remarks: First reported as a guerrilla leader operating in the Valona area on Feb. 25, 1943. Again mentioned in an April 24, 1943, report. Lujo was reported to have worked with Lopencia. When Lopencia was killed, Major Aziz Cumi (Cumi) became military commander of the BK in the Valona area. He was unsatisfactory and Skender Kano, up to then the political chief of the BK in southern Albania, became military commander. Lujo proposed collaboration. He eventually resigned this position and Isuf Luzaj (No. 23) took over.

A late report says that Lujo is in hiding. Despite protestations, he is not fighting the Germans.

Remarks: Luzaj took over the military command of the BK in the Valona area, succeeding Skender Yuco. He is described as having "pockets filled with German gold."

24. MOISIU, Spiro

Other spelling: Moisiu

Party: LNC. He is called a Communist but this is doubtful.

Remarks: Holding the rank of a major, Moisiu is referred to as commander-in-chief of the IMC military forces, estimated to number some 5000 men, with an additional 5000 reserves. (The partisans claim that they can raise 40,000 men, given the proper supplies.)

Moisiu works with Imer Mezha (No. 161), president of LNC and on its General Staff. Both of these men are very important figures.

25. MLESHTI, Maxhi

Party: C. and LNC. Anti-Zog.

Remarks: He has been in contact with Bajraktari (No. 1) and Baba Faja (No. 36). A declared Communist. A Dec. 24, 1943, report says that he clashed with the Germans at Dibra.
