1. The following information or	Subject was received	from $\square$ on 13 January

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- 2. Jusuf LUZAY, son of the late Mohamed and Murai (nee KYRI) LUZAY, was born in Kanina, Vlone, off 21 February 1914. Also known as Piero VALCADO, son of the late Mario, born in Fossano, Italy, on 30 March 1909.
- 3. Subject is not listed in the records of the Bureau of Vital Statistics (Anagrafe) of the Commune of Rome.
  - 4. Files of the Rome Questura reflect the following information:
- a. 25 September 1940: Sentenced by the Judge of Ponza (Comment: Enforced residence location for political prisoners against Fascism) to three months arrest for violating enforced residence regulations. Sentence suspended for two years.
- b. 21 February 1946: Brescia Questura issued arrest order for the apprehension of Subject. Subject escaped while awaiting trial (for swindle and falsification of official documents) from the Brescia hospital, where he was hospitalized under guard.
- c. 11 July 1946: Subject was arrested by the Mobile Squad of the Rome Questura and denounced to the courts for swindling one Giuseppina Pisciotta. On this occasion Subject identified himself as Piero VALCADO.
- d. 22 August 1946: Freed from Regina Coeli prison in Rome and acquitted of charges of swindling. Was placed on temporary liberty but remained at the disposition of the Pubblica Sicurezza police, to ascertain his true identity.
- e. 30 October 1946: The Rome courts sentenced Subject to 9 month's imprisonment for declaration of false identity.
- f. 26 October 1947: The Questura of Brescia revoked the order issued on 21 February 1946 for apprehension of Subject inasmuch as he was amnestied.
