As was stated in paragraph 1 of ref. D, OIR-18769 essentially summarizes all the information available in Headquarters on Subject. However, traces have been run, turning up several KUNWIN reports dated 1944 to 1946. They contain very brief references to Subject's wartime activity in Albania, which can be summarized as follows:</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">Isuf LUSAJ was a member of the Northern Central Committee of the Balli Kombetar (National Front) party, an actively anti-Communist party. He took over the military command of this party in the Valona area, succeeding Skender MUCO, with whom he disagreed over policies of collaboration with the Axis. LUSAJ was described as having "his pockets filled with German gold."</p> <p>3. In addition to this information, Headquarters traces turned up an ODACID dispatch, No. 1230, dated 10 April 1957, concerning the Argentine delegation to the Congress Against Soviet Intervention in Latin America, which was to be held in Lima, Peru, from 11 to 14 April 1957.
