Naval Academy, 1913. Career: naval attache to Japanese Embassy in Poland; staff
member, Naval General Staff; captain of HINA; naval attache to Japanese Embassy
in Moscow; section chief, Naval General Staff; chief, Publicity Section,
Navy Ministry and Navy Department of Imperial Headquarters, appointed December 1940.
Address: 627, Kitasenjou-machi, Oseri-ku, Tokyo. 5/
Information dated 1/8/44 states that Vice Admiral Maeda Minoru was succeeded by
Rear Admiral NAKAMURA Katsubui as naval Attache, Japanese Embassy, Nanking, and
was transferred to another (un-named) post. 1/ According to a ~~news~~ radio broadcast
from Peking in Japanese on 25 November 1950, Vice Admiral MAEDA Minoru was
appointed by General MacArthur to be an adviser to the US fleets which were
reported to be blockading the Korean seas at that time.
