1. Shipping and Smuggling.

c. (Date of Information: 19 Jan 1951.) The Jonan Enterprises Co.'s shipping operations which are to commence during the months of January and February to Ukinawa and Formosa will NOT carry operational personnel for any intelligence group; it was previously reported that transportation for the individual liaison officers of the ARISUE Kikan might be provided, but the new policy of the NPIPC and the Jonan Company group entails no active operations at all, and definitely no "servicing" for the ARISUE groups. FURUYA wants to go to Formosa for personal talks with both Lt. General NEMOTO and Chinese Nationalist figures there, but whether that trip will actually be made is still doubtful. Reasons for FURUYA going himself are generally that Admiral Kubarashi Shozaburo and the leaders of the NPIPC-Jonan Group do not feel that Vice Admiral MAEDA Minoru & Toxon (or(Int. General MATANABE Ikujiro), who conducts the main liaisons to NEMOTO and the Formosa HQ of the Chinese Nationalists, other than those liaisons which are affiliated with ARISUE Seizo, does not know the Chinese sufficiently nor possess enough top-leval contacts among them to be fully effective......
