1. Transmitted herewith is one copy of a report on the MHBK given to us by GRAGLET 1 on 15 November.

2. This report is a British translation and collation of information contained in the papers of Sandor ~~DEMY-GERO~~ (alias Pal DVORZSAK), acquired by the Austrian police shortly after the attempted abduction of Laszlo SARVARY by the Soviets in the International Sector on 12 October 1951. This material was turned over to the French after the Austrian police had passed it clandestinely to the British for their examination.

3. In handing this report to [] made the following remarks:

a. The British particularly desire that the French not learn that the British acquired the material, and that we therefore treat the report as highly sensitive.

b. The papers made it apparent that the organization (MHBK) was penetrated by the AVH. However, GRAGLET 1 stated that the penetration affected only a section controlled by the French IS, and that while the British controlled part of the MHBK, this latter part was unaffected by the penetration. [] remarked, "We keep very close control over our part."

c. [] requested that one copy of this report, in which G-2, USFA was interested, be transmitted to G-2 through our channels.

4. Photocopies of the report have been transmitted to the Salzburg base and to G-2, USFA. One copy is being retained here.

ACTIVITIES OF VIENNA INTELLIGENCE BRANCH

OF HUNGARIAN EMIGRE ORGANISATION

(M. H. B. K.)

1. The files covered the period autumn 1950 to October 6 1951 and contained correspondence, reports etc. of the VIENNA Intelligence Branch of the MAGYAR HARCOSOK BAJTARSI KOZOSSEGE (M.H.B.K.) (Comradeship of Hungarian Veterans), a patriotic anti-communist organisation. They appear to have some connection with TIBOR ECKHARDT, leader of Free Hungarians in the USA during the war. Mention is also made of KLGs, an associated organisation not identified.
2. The organisation has been working in close liaison with French Intelligence. Though the organisation's independence is repeatedly emphasized, the writers admit that they cannot function without the assistance of a great power.
- French assistance appears to have consisted of the supply of means of communication for urgent messages, supply of false documents, protection against other allies where agents' paths crossed, information on doubtful contacts, and some financial assistance. *military*
- In return M.H.B.K. has supplied ~~the~~ information secured from couriers and refugees, and has organised frontier crossings into Hungary for French agents, through the channels used by their own agents. The French were not allowed to know names of MHBK's contacts. Contact with CIC and FSS appears to have taken place only where individual cases demanded it.

3. The activities of the VIENNA Branch of MHBK appear to have consisted of:

- (a) Counter-espionage in VIENNA
- (b) Interrogation of refugees and smugglers to obtain military and political information about Hungary
- (c) Routing of couriers from the Western Zones of Austria across the Hungarian frontier.

The activities of the couriers in Hungary cannot be established from the Files, apart from collecting information and supplying wireless sets to agents there.

DVORZSAK appears from the files to be extremely touchy -
he reacts with lengthy letters of explanation and counter-
accusation to any hint of criticism from his own superiors
and particularly from the French. This usually results in
soothing letters from both, saying how much they value him.

21. Came to VIENNA on 24 March 1951 via SEMMERING with instructions
to use cover name of Bruno LASZLO, Volksdeutsch from Hungary.
Never received the papers for this name and did not use it.
16 was instructed to contact him on arrival under the No.
A 50-6-66 and A 30-6-66 (one is obviously a typing error)
asking for SARVARY.

Counter-espionage and interrogation of refugees from
Hungary. Contact was made with these through various "B"
men, the only ones specifically mentioned being the porters
of the PAZMANEUN, the Hungarian seminary, and of the
Ledigeheim, where the Americans used to house refugees
pending interrogation. Military deserters were usually
sent down to PC for detailed interrogation.

Agents claiming to represent "friendly" organisations.

MULLER, Jozsef ✓

(a) A report from VIENNA to INNSBRUCK states that he is thought to be engaged by a Hungarian group of similar sympathies to MHBK, though known to KELEMEN LAJOS, who claims to be a British Agent. He went to Hungary via VIENNA and was nearly caught by AVO in ZIRZ. Took refuge in VIENNA on return first with American, then with 21, who supplied guide and money to get him to LINZ (guide MATYAS FISCHER). 21 presumes there is an agent of his organisation in SALZBURG, as he got money from there while in VIENNA. No representative of his organisation in VIENNA. Left his pistol and map with 21 and will collect them when he returns to VIENNA in 3-4 months time.

Contacts in VIENNA prior to trip to Hungary (not intelligence workers, but smugglers) LANCZI, Bela, FISCHER Matyas, KADAR Robert. His relations in ZIRZ are now unsafe.

(b) INNSBRUCK later reported his arrival in MUNICH and confirmed he really was agent of a group there with the same interests as MHBK.

(c) In September 16 reported the arrival of MULLER Karoly (mistake for Jozsef?) who tried to contact 16, alleging his principles were the same.

HAHOTY, Sandor

Living in SALZBURG. In charge of an "I" line with terminus in England. Nothing against him, but there is a warning against having anything to do with him.

Dr. TAKACS, Jozsef

Often seen with PALFI in WASIL Gasthaus. Told PALFI he belonged to ZOMBORI movement (MINDSZENTY Group?) which is operating successfully in Hungary. 21 is in touch with PALFI on the subject.

GESZELYI, Mihaly,
van FLEET,

There is an account of activities in MUNICH up to June 1951 of one GESZELYI Mihaly, van FLEET and others claiming or suspected to have been employed at various times by Belgian, American, Russian and German secret services. The writer says the OV in MUNICH is actually concerned with the affair but asks: can PB in VIENNA discover whether there is a "Mixed"/

a "Mixed intelligence net" or an "M" organisation there, and if so whether the afore-mentioned names are known.

Subject: KELEMEN Lajos, alleged English secret agent, Born in
Hungary
1924 in SOPRON. Address: VIENNA, Gumpersdorferstr. 17, left Hungary in May 22 1950, came to Austria, thence to MUNICH. Here contacted English espionage service and was entrusted with mission to Hungary. Returned alone to Austria on 13 February 1951, having lost his two companions, (Dr) NAGY ZOLTAN, and a councillor from the heavy industry Ministry, n.u. KELEMEN had been promised 4,000 dollars for execution of his mission. Alleges he did not get entire sum for which he blames an English major, who said he would only get the full sum after his next journey. He was ill after his return and the British paid for his stay in hospital. 21 is of the opinion that he is still in touch with British and receiving money from them; although he claims to get money from his brother in MUNICH. Wants to go to MUNICH shortly. 21 asks for information as to whether there is a British Intelligence ("II") group in MUNICH. He notes K. knows MULLERJozsef personally and knew his services had been engaged. Possibly both engaged by same organisation.

A note from 04 to L6 dated 20. 8. 51. in reply states KELEMEN born in FERTOEWDRIED in 1924. War in army and engaged in smuggling people. After discharge continued smuggling and worked for the British in VIENNA. At the beginning of 1951 (?) at their request called on an Englishman named BLACK in the BAJZA-uten, BUDAPEST, for orders. BLACK threw him out, two AVO men were waiting at the house door, but he succeeded in talking himself out of trouble. Says he has done a lot of work for the British but they never pay properly. Has friends POGACS and LINDNER in MUNICH. We are checking KELEMEN's statements with the British.

APPENDIX "D"

Details of couriers.

(a) There appears to have been a twice-weekly postal service between VIENNA and the Western Zones. 16 and 21's meeting place for delivery and collection of courier post in VIENNA was in the XIV district, under the bridge over the railway in the SCHLOSSALLEE at 1800 hours on Mondays and Thursdays.

(b) Couriers to Hungary always come up from and return to the Western Zones. They are given guides between BISHOFSHOFEN and VIENNA and the frontier.

At the beginning of October, owing to obvious insecurity of the whole group, instructions were given that no couriers were to be sent over until after 15 October, and then only the point 110 was to be used.

APPENDIX "E"

The various crossing points are described as "doors", the local guides as "concierges". The couriers are usually, but not invariably, brought down by guides from VIENNA, who hand them over to the concierges. The concierge provides food, shelter, takes charge of superfluous papers, money etc., and guides the courier to within 500 metres of the frontier. Routes in great detail and maps are among the material studied. The following is a rough outline.

KAROLY Robert (address unknown) Jew. Good friend of SLAMM. A year ago was representative of smugglers of persons. ?? Agent of STB.

SCHEIN Bela (address unknown). About 26, small, thin, dark, Jew. Has an office in "Kaufmännische Zentralbureau".

(Departmental Note: Is very well known as a member of Hungarian Trading Mission in VIENNA). Said to be certain to be engaged also in political activities.

Colleagues: VERES Karoly, Tenimpox manager.

JUNGER Karoly, Hungarian commercial office in FRANKFURT/MAIN.

LANGER Dezsö, WESSEL, f.n.u., colleagues of JUNGER.

Supplied by H.C. (French Liaison)

TAKACS, Dr. Alexander (ex-Hungarian officer-captain). Often goes to DORNBIRN and BREGENZ. Seeks to contact former Hungarian policemen. Lived in VIENNA. Said to have left. Said to work for AVO.

TAKACS Mihaly, engineer at RADESTHEIN. Possibly relation of TAKACS Jozsef?

HILLASZ Imre, in contact with eastern organisations (Satellites & Soviet).

MEUZINGER Josef, ex-AVO agent. Not known whether he is still in AVO service.

KRATKY Vilmos - driver for Americans. Source of information for HILLASZ Imre. Often at Cafe Wastl.

BICHLER, STADLER, ZOLI } First worked for the French and then went over to the Americans because they were sacked. Were also discharged for cheating the Americans. They were first imprisoned, for the last month have worked independently selling information. They used to live opposite Hotel Krummer but have moved. Whereabouts unknown. Caution.

KUCSERA alias BOXBAUM - smuggler of people. According to his cousin in MUNICH lives in VIENNA. Agent of AVO who betrays those who engage his services to get to Hungary. VIENNA IV, Heumuhlgasse (house unknown).

KEIMICH Ferenc - born in 1911 in TRANSYLVANIA. Was in PARIS in 1949, registered as Rumanian. Appeared in MUNICH in October 1949. Alleged to have Russian papers and get instructions from Russian agents. Speaks Rumanian, German, Hungarian. Alleged to be living since January 1951 with his family in Russian sector of VIENNA.

WFTU

17 reports on 28 April that the World Federation of Trade

Unions compiles a "grey bulletin" similar to the "green bulletin" appearing in BERLIN on personalities, activities etc. of emigrants in Austria. It employs 50-60 officials sent from Hungary who all speak perfect German and are housed in the Bellaria.

✓ SZUCS Jozsef, (Colonel) - possibly eastern agent (Source HC).

✓ FARKAS Sandor (born in 18.4.27 in MEZOTUR) ^{Hungary} Turned up in MUNICH. Alleges he left TOROKSZENIMIKLOS on 1. 5. 51 and was in MUNICH by 5.5.51. Suspicious character.

✓ KABANYI (KOSCHIER) Zoltan. Emigrated in 1945, lived in SALZBURG till 1947, when discovery of his black-market activities drove him to French Zone. Since 1949 Austrian police suspect him of being a communist agent. Lived till summer 1950 with a KPO member called NIEDERWANGER. Was in touch with a former SS officer called Hans SACHS and his landlady Edit TAKACS. These two are engaged in some kind of "I" work. In May 1950, KABANYI visited IRO with the Duchess of Cobourg to see MRIFFEY Lajos. Stated to be interesting because the Duchess at that time was in touch with a Viennese Jew called LIEBSCHUTZ Mihaly, VIENNA I, Elisabethstr. 24/23, who once crossed BK's path in INNSBRUCK. Our impression was that he was a communist (Russian) agent. We dropped the affair as we discovered he had close connections with the Surete. He has a press card from the "News Chronicle". He was in GRAZ in spring this year and visited the house KAISER FRANZ JOSEFSTR. 20 several times. Two weeks ago he reappeared and photographed Ol's neighbourhood carefully (cf. BOGNER) Suggested WANN Lajos trying to work his way into K's confidence. K. is connected with FRADLERSTR. 35 in INNSBRUCK. At this address live Julius ZEBENTNER and his son Walter ZEBENTNER. Main tenant is Franz FLICK. Tel.No. 76-46-2. KABANYI and ZEBENTNER use this number. At night WOLFEISSER (Mrs.) nee SZABO Maria can be reached on this number. The latter is definitely pro-communist. KABANYI also has a flat at Mozartstr. 6 in INNSBRUCK. His girl friend is a Pole, BRZLEZYCKA, formerly girl-friend of MAGY Vilmos, INNSBRUCK, Elisabethstr. 11, known to be in touch with Russian organisations.

✓ KOROKNAY Inre, Canada. Suspected of being sender of a packet of old VIENNA BK "I" notes, of circulars referring to the "Austro-Hungarian Society for Culture and Science" and Hungarian propaganda.

✓ LACI, Nezsider. Railway employee, "LOCSEY Type".

✓ REDEY. Smuggler, possibly connected with LOCSEY.

✓ SZILAGYI introduced REDEY to KOLEF.

✓ KOLEF negotiated with Russians in August at SCHWEDENPLATZ Cafe.

✓ SZABO Kathi, VIENNA IX, Porzellangasse 7/a - connected with Russians, and receives payment for betraying refugees to them.

FORBATH agreed to go to the next

next meeting, but told 06 and 16. 06 took him to the Americans, but they said they were not interested, as FORBATH was working for the French. IVANYI mentioned the case to the French, who promised to have DAJKA arrested and to get FORBATH out, but they had first to contact PARIS.

No answer came by Friday. Writer (?16) watched FORBATH's flat on Friday morning but he did not go out to meet the Russians. The writer spoke to FORBATH at midday, but he said he would not go to meet the Russians under any circumstances.

In the meantime HANUSZ Laszlo was brought into the affair. He worked at the ELZETT Key Factory. The manager of the factory warned him the Russians were enquiring about him and he left immediately. DAJKA had revealed to the Russians that his family in BUDAPEST wished to escape.

PAK Istvan, about 23 years old, called on FORBATH and said an old business connection wanted to settle a debt - FORBATH should go with him to collect it. He wanted FORBATH to get in a car waiting outside the house, but this F. would not do. It subsequently turned out that the debtor had been dead for a week. PAK is therefore probably an AVH or Russian agent.

APPENDIX "M"

Events presumably leading up to attempted kidnapping of SARVARY.

The picture is not at all clear, but the general sequence of events appears to have been the following:

In August the AVO got hold of 21's wife (location unknown) and then approached 21 in an attempt to blackmail him into giving information.

(Departmental Note: 21 is presumed to be SARVARY).

21 appears to have given them the impression of being willing to co-operate, and then to have reported to his own people. DVORZSAK reported the matter to his supervisor at INNSBRUCK, who planned to keep the affair from the French, keep the AVO satisfied with harmless or false information via 21 until his wife was released, then get both 21 and 16 out of VIENNA as quickly as possible. (Departmental Note: 16 is DVORZSAK see p. 3.)

There is a letter dated 11 August from 04 to 21, briefing him on what to tell the AVO at his next meeting. He may admit to interrogating refugees and acquiring their papers, but only for profit, his principal being JAKO-JEZIERSKY, Hotel Stein, SOLRAD HALL. He may admit to knowing DVORZSAK Pal and confirm anything AVO knows about him, but not volunteer anything else.

However, 04 in INNSBRUCK mentioned the matter to 26, who informed MARTIN and BERNEAU, apparently French contacts, who demanded that 21 should immediately cease all activities and all contact with 16. MHBK protested that this was extremely foolish, as it would immediately make the AVO suspicious. The course of the argument is not clear - there seems to have been a certain lack of liaison between the Zone and VIENNA on both sides, - until on October 6th. 16 received instructions from PA to suspend all courier activity until after 15 October. He on the same day informed him that of the three recently returned couriers (A-37, A-39 and C-42), one went over to the AVH in Hungary and was sent back. HC subjected 16 to severe interrogation as to his contacts in VIENNA, whether he had not observed anything suspicious etc.; ordered that no further use be made of previous guides and cross points, except that 110 might be used after 15 October. (Date of 21's

There is a long letter from 16 to 04 written on 6 October declaring his readiness to have the whole case investigated, but expressing his opinion on how easily the AVH could have traced the organisation, e.g. through couriers always using the same routes, same means of recognition etc.

There is no later correspondence than this letter of 6 October 1951.

In Appendix "F" (Hostile Personnel), page 14, there is an extract from an undated manuscript report on the defection of one DAJKA to the AVH. It is not clear whether this may have some connection with the approach to 21, (who is presumed to be SARVARY) and the attempted kidnapping of SARVARY in VIENNA in October 1951.
