Reference is made to the verbal request of SA Edward Kehlusek of your Washington Field Office for a check of Agency information in regard to captioned subject. A check of Agency records has revealed only the following information which is believed identical to the individual of interest to your Bureau.

One Boleslavs Maikovskis, whose birth date was given as 21 January 1904, Mesteri, Latvia, and his wife, Janina Maikovskis, whose birth date was given as 21 January 1914, Subnaito, Latvia, were among a list of cases rejected under Section 13 of Public Law 774, as amended. This information, which was contained on list #24 of the United States Displaced Persons Commission, was prior to 1951.

Other information indicates that as of 1951 the above Boleslavs Maikovskis and his wife, Janina, nee Ritins, were residing at Pinnsberg/Hamburg, Auslaenderlager, Germany.

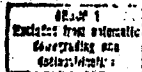
