On September 4, 1968, a confidential course, who has furnished reliable information in the past, advised that on this date Edward Cohen of Mincola, New York, whose telephone number is 741-0747, was in contact with a female employee of the Consular Division of the Embassy of the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics (UESE), Washington, B.C. (UEC), at which time he inquired as to the status of the extradition proceedings against Follows Maihavehis, who was tried in Riga, Letvia, in March, 1965, and whose extradition was requested in June, 1965. Cohen stated he represented a group which desired the extradition of Maihavehis. The employee, whose identity was not known to the source, informed Cohen that Vitautas M. Zenhevichyus handles matters of this type and that he would contact Cohen later that day.

The source has received no information indicating that Zonkovichyes contacted Cohon regarding above natter.

The August, 1968, issue of the "Diplomatic List," a publication of the United States Department of State, reflects that Vitautas M. Zembervickus was them a First Secretary of the USER Imbacry, NDC.
