1. CIC has record of one Vasile MAILAT who in March 1948 was the Austrian leader of Group I of the Rumanian Iron Guard. Intelligence Division, EUCOM, reports no traces.
2. One Vasile MAILLAT, Legionnaire, is mentioned in an April 1945 list of Rumanians as a war criminal and pro-Nazi.
3. Another report in Karl files lists Subject as one of the SIMA group which fled from Rumania to Germany after the "Rebellion of January 1941". Same report states he is presently one of SIMA's representatives, living in Linz, Austria.
