1. Our file on Ernst MAKOWSKI, © Ernst HERBST, © Thorsten-Heinz WINKLER, © Rudolf PETERS, V-615 contains the following information:

a. Subject's UJVENTURE sheet, which lists his DPOB as 20 March 1913 in Emericch/Rhine, stated that his wife's name was Ida MAKOWSKI and that they had a child named Dietmunde MAKOWSKI. In 1951 Subject was sub-agency leader for Dienststelle 12. In 1953 he resided at Berlin-Neukölln, Weserstrasse 180. A 1955 description was also given - 6' tall, 209 lbs., blue eyes, dark blond hair. He held KK No. II/2501/53.

b. EGMA-49231 dated 17 May 1960 requested a BDC check on Ernst MAKOWSKI, born 10 March 1913 in Gross-Neubrau, Kreis Marienwerder. His occupation was listed as Krim.-Sekretär. At that time he resided at Munich 25, Schaeftlarnstrasse 164/V. Subject had previously resided in Berlin; his evacuation number, DGZ-664, had appeared on a list of "Springer's" from Dienststelle 12. This dispatch also gave an explanation for the difference in Subject's DPOB. The 20 March birth date was used, apparently in 1953, in documenting Subject under the name Thorsten-Heinz WINKLER.

c. EGWA-64097 dated 29 June 1960 forwarded,
to Munich only, two copies of Subject's EDC file.

d. MHNICM-7004 and 7006 (slugged UJEBOWSY)
dated August 1961 requested traces on Subject, who
in 1953 was head of the Eisenstelle 12 Sub-Office
in Berlin.

e. FRAN-3177 dated August 1961 indicated that
the name Rudolf PETERS was reported in November 1955
as an alias used by a CATWEX recruiter and refugee
interviewer.

2. We have no information on Ernst MAKOWSKI subsequent
to the August 1961 traces and the Frankfurt reply. The other
replies contained no additional information.
