

NICOLAE MALAXA

47-85

1. Family -

In, Niccolae MALAXA lives at ALMA CIBCIOIU 34,  
BUCHAREST, Rumanian citizen, Orthodox belief. Born at FUSI  
in 1885. Married Nat. lia, father of two children.

The elder child, IRINA, born in BUCURESTI in 1919,  
married Incor. Dr. PALADE, who is a doctor and assistant in  
the Physiological laboratory of the Faculty of Medicine,  
BUCHAREST. She lives with her husband in the villa which  
she received as dowry from her father, on the CHAUSSÉE  
BUCHAREST - PLOIESTI, between kilometres 16-17 (OTOPENI).

Dr. PALADE is known to be in sympathy with the  
Legionaries. Irina PALADE lives in OTOPENI for two differ-  
ent reasons:

1. Her husband's jealousy

2. Fear of air raids in BUCHAREST.

She had a very tempestuous and adventurous youth  
and is supposed to have also lived with Gen. ANTON. She  
has now SIBICEANU (Cabinet Director Gh. TATARIAN) as lover.

The second child, Constantin MALAXA, born in 1922 is  
a student. He lives with the actress Nuti DIMITRESCU, residing  
at str. ROMANEI 94, 3rd floor, telephone 23583.

MALAXA's sister, Clea, lives at STR. LAPINA 14 ; she  
was born October 21st 1904 at GALATZ ; carries identity  
card BIROUL POPULAREI No. 1987, Circa II, issued by the  
BUCHAREST Prefecture of Police.

2. Political and Commercial -

MALAXA was the partner of Kin. ANTON in the  
MALAXA Metal and Industrial Works. He is a good and devoted  
friend of Gen. ANTON, Mr. CONGRATINESCU, the present  
Minister, Ing. G. G. M. President of the council of management  
of the Romanian Railways.

At the present moment MALAXA is on very bad terms  
with Ing. N. A., general OREZANU, Minister general DOBRE,  
Dimitri director of ASTRA-ROMANA, former director of MALAXA  
Works, Adrien DIMITRESCU, former director at MALAXA Works.

Since Nihai ANTON (O) is interested in the MALAXA  
Works, the latter two months ago issued an ordinance, whereby  
the OCIMF Works passed into the hands of Nicolae MALAXA.  
Minister general DOBRE opposed this retransfer of  
his property.
