Radescu explained the apparent discrepancy between his statement that
Malaxa was in possession of his factories in Dec. 1944, with the fact that the de-
cree granting Malaxa control over his works was not signed until April 12, 1945, by
stating_that_both_Malaxa_and_Ausnit_assumed_control_of_their_factories_shortly_after
the Armistice in Sept 1944. He stated that he was unaware of the decree of October
9, 1943, which gave back to Malaxa his rights of ownership over his property. Radescu
pointed out that although the decree which returned Malaxa to control of his factories
and reimbursed him for the use of his factories by the Rumanian Government and the
seizure of the tube mill by the Russians was signed after he was desposed as Prime
Minister, he was responsible for its inception. He also pointed out that although the
pro-Communist Government of Peter Groza was in power at the time, they did not have
complete control and there was still a semblance of democratic procedure. He was
unable to explain why this decree called for reimbursement to Malaxa in foreign
currency.
Gen. Radescu stated that after his interview with Malaxa in Dec 1944, he
did not see him again until April 26, 1948.
Cen. Fadescu had no personal knowledge concerning the question of why
Malaxa was permitted to leave Rumania. He stated that Malaxa probably pretended that
he was not opposed to the Communists and paid a large sum to Bodnaras in order to
leave Rumania. (The foregoing not to be disseminated)
In late April 1948, Gen Radescu stated that he was receiving funds from
Nicolae Malaxa, during an interview with the Director of CIA (not to be disseminated)
As of March 1948, Malaxa's wife and son were reported still in Rumania.
