1. Nic MAIAXA is presently residing in New York, at the Sherry-Netherlands Hotel. He is accompanied by his daughter, Irene Land his son-in-law, MAIADE (fnu).

- 2. Subject is reported to be an enormously wealthy self-made manufacturer, who had a number of steel mills and other "heavy industry" factories in Fumania.
- 3. Several of these factories were dismantled and sent to Russia, in payment of war-damage claims. For these he was paid, in dollars, by the GROSZA regime (sic).
- 4. Toward the end of April 1946, several other factories belonging to Mbject were seized by the government. It was at this time that Mrs. Nic MALAXA and their son, Costache WALAXA (a 26/27 year old engineer), were allowed to leave Rumania.
- 5. Mrs. MAIAXA and Costache MAIAXA proceeded to Istanbul by boat, whence they are reported to have left for Switzerland, enroute to the U.S.
- 6. It is the opinion of I that Subject is not a Communist, but is an extraordinarily shrewd businessman who may have entered into some sort of a "combinazione" in order to save a part of his fortune and get his family out of Rumania.
