Nicolae Radescu has likewise accepted funds from Nicolae Malaxa, a Rumanian industrialist presently in the United States. Malaxa supported the Germans and financed the fascist Iron Guard before Rumania entered the war. Following Rumanian armistice he began to collaborate with the Russians and the Rumanian Communists, receiving large sums in compensation for factories removed to the USSR. He is the only Rumanian to receive such compensation. He came to the U.S. in late 1946, ostensibly on a trade mission, and has remained. At the present time he is financing General Radescu and a number of his supporters, including Brutus Goste, formerly charge in Lisbon. This activity on the part of Malaxa is the reason for our recent request for information on the source of funds paid out for scholarships by Eliade, in the name of General Radescu.
