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of the Liberal farty of humania. There was no further partiment comment relative to halaZA on this day's entry.

Under the entry of Jamuary 17, MHAI ANTICONOUS wrote that he had another discussion with MANAX and that he had pointed out to WOWN that if he, MANAX, would work with us (meaning the ANTIMESON regime in Eumannie), that his situation could be adjusted. ANTIMESON again writes that MAIAAA spoke favorably of HIMATACONE.

ANTIMESON ANALASME

It should be noted at this point that the entries in ETHAI ARTOHNSCU'S diary and the GRETING letter to SAIAXA were the only pieces of evidence which AUSHIT had in his possession and which he stated be wished to make available to the FUI and which he felt would conclusively reflect on EXAIAXA's activities as collaborator with the German Iron Guard in Russais during World War II.

In continuing the narrative biographical comments on his life during two war, AUSHIT went on to my that in Jane, 1944, he had been told by a close friend of his in Rumania that he should lay plans to excape the country. He said it was suggested to him that he flee to Egypt and that an he was making plans to do so, time passed so rapidly that the war was over before he was able to escape. He stated than that he decided to remain in Rumania and that he was endeavoring to adjust his own situation in the most favorable manner possible for him.

AUSHIT mentioned that a coelition government was set up in Russina and that ministers of the departments were appointed who would be nost favorable to the Eusmiss. In 1965 TATARECT who was then serving as Trime Minister of Eusmis, was induced, AUGHIT said, by MALAKA to join the Communist Party. This happened, according to AUSHIT, after VISHINSKY had sade a special mission to lumanis from Mussis. Shortly after this AUSHIT said that MALAKA received reparation payment for his factories which had been taken from his for war purposen by the occupying governments. AUSHIT said that MALAK received approximately #4,000,000.00 and that this was in payment for his factories, some of which were taken by Mussia and later rebuilt in the Russian mone. He said that of this \$4,000,000.00, MALAKA was able to have approximately \$2,500,000.00 released in order that he could have it converted into United Atabes currency.
