were friendly. The informant stated that he is of the opinion that MANA is definitely enti-Communist. He said that M. IAM gave money to anyone whom he thought might prove useful to him. The informant stated that Madem. MINESCU was a friend of MANASA. (Madem CHESCU is the wife of MANASAMENESCU, a famous Ameanian violinist, presently residing in the United States). Hadam EMESCU's first husband, CANTAGUZERU, was one of the wealthiest persons in Humania, and deporting to the informant, was Humanian Minister of Justice prior to World Sar 7.

Confidential informant T-6 advised that FLERIN Zahkhia, a former humanian larger, who about twenty years ago was the personal corretary of MICHAEL CARTACUZARU, Russman Minister of Justice, is now employed as personal secretary to MICHAEL MALAKA.

AUGAR and MAK AUSHIT were interviewed by the Immigration and saturalization Service at New York City on March 9, 1949. EDGAR AUSHIT stated that he believed Walala to be a "pay-off" man for the Communists. We stated that since he has been in the United States for more than ten years, he is not in a position to testify to occurrences in Aumania during the war years.

MAX ABSHIT stated that while he was willing to some questions concerning UALAXA, he did not desire, at this time, to sake any seora statement or to make a statement recorded by a stanographer. He strined that due to the litigation pending between UALAXA and him, he did not care to be put in the position of having volumbered information to any government agency concerning MALAXA since it might conceivably effect the litigation in some manner.

During the interview, W.I. AUST IN did nest of the telking. Much of the information supplied by the AUSSITS concerning MATAKA's background and activities in Rumenia has already been reported. Additional points made by MATAUSNIT are set forth as follows:
