follows reimbursement for the factory that had seen dismanbled, he must have seen cooperating with the Communist government in Bussais and with the Lucaisms. It was clear that a recember must have been made above by this money could be aid him outside of fumanis, in other words, in sen fork up it was made. The means of transmitting these funds included the sending of exports of merchandise from musuals to this country where it was disposed of through Malaka. Further, exports were sent through the Asimb distribution argumination of New York City, again for disposal by declare.

The AMENTA have information that the name of MANIA appeared in a notebook found in the possession of one VINANU, an employee of the Amenian Amenian in mixerland, who was recently arrested in that country as an agent provocateur of the Communists. The AMENITS stated that they have amorted that Commissioner WEDRICH of the Mederal Police in Morne, Switzer-land, has asked coveral persons for information concerning MANAA and his apparent commention with VITEANU. (The AMENITS furnished the name of one SCHVANI, Traident of the Amenian Banke de Credit, Turich, Switzerland, as a person who might give further information on this point if approached).

In suggestion, the ACONITS stated they consider MALAL to be a dangerous person because of his faculty of influencing persons and obtaining his ends by the use of any and all means. They believe MALAL either directly or indirectly instigated the killing of the 7,000 Joys in humania, at the time of the insurrection of the Iron hand. As another example, they cited the case in which a time Simister of humania, CALIMETOU, who served under King CATALA, was assessinated on the street in Bucharest, allegedly because he was keeping King TATAL from openly joining the Maula. The witnesses claim that CALIMETOU was assessinated because he was an enemy of the Iron Guard and of MALALA, and they attribute such assessination indirectly to MALALA.

MAX AUGSIT furnished photostatic copies of certain documents which he indicated substantiates his story concerning MAIAIA's activities. Translations of these documents were made by the Immigration and Materalization certice, and those documents not already in possession of the Hursau, or previously reported, are numerized as follows:
