Dear Mr. Attorney General:

This Agency has been approached by a representative of Nicolae Malaxa, Rumanian industrialist presently in the United States, who has supplied certain memoranda from Malaxa and photostats of certain documents purporting to refute information concerning Malaxa contained in a memorandum from the Central Intelligence Agency to the Director of the Federal Bureau of Investigation, dated 11 May 1948. This memorandum was introduced in evidence at the trial of Judith Coplon in Washington, D. C., as part of a report of the Federal Bureau of Investigation. A review of the material submitted by Malaxa's representative leads us to believe that it consists of documents carefully selected to place the activities of Malaxa in the best possible light.

The representative of Malaxa has stated that other representatives of this individual have interviewed you or your representatives and have been informed that the Department of Justice holds no derogatory information on Malaxa except that contained in the memorandum from the Central Intelligence Agency to the Director of the Federal Bureau of Investigation, to which reference was made above.

While we are inclined to doubt the accuracy of these statements, in order that the allegations made by Malaxa's representative to us may be fully evaluated and to complete our files, it will be appreciated if you will furnish to this Agency pertinent information relative to any such interview with you or your representatives held by representatives of Malaxa.
