SUBJECT : Deportation of Nicolae MALAXA

1. It is understood that a deportation hearing in the case of Nicolae MALAXA will be held in Washington on 23 March 1951.
2. Mr. Malaxa has a long history of unsavory collaboration with the Iron Guard and Nazi Germans in Rumania in 1939 - 1943 and with the Rumanian Communist Party in 1944 - 1945. Moreover, by virtue of his wealth, which he has been able to keep intact, he has since his arrival in the United States allegedly been successful in subverting members of Rumanian Refugee Groups for his own purposes. Through the use of bribery and subsidy he has gained control of certain important refugee leaders in the U. S. and in Europe. The purpose of such machinations is presumed to be directed toward:
  - a) the gaining of recognition as a reformed and democratic personage, and
  - b) the building of support for his future position in a liberated Rumania.
3. It is considered that the continued presence of Nicolae MALAXA in the United States is undesirable and is detrimental to a successful unification of Rumanian Refugees.
