<p>This investigation is predicated upon a request from Confidential Informant T-1, of known reliability, to ascertain if MARCELINA ALAXA, the wife of NICOLAI ALAXA, is presently in the United States.</p> <p>Confidential Informant T-2, of known reliability, advised on April 12, 1948 that MARCELINA ALAXA, age 66, departed from Rio de Janeiro, Brazil, on February 11, 1949, bound for New York via Pan American Airways flight number 806. She was travelling on Rumanian passport number 005841, accompanied by ION TATIIN ALAXA, age 26, who was travelling on Rumanian passport number 005891, and TEFAN ALAXA.</p> <p>Confidential Informant T-3, of known reliability, on July 6, 1951, advised the writer, from personal knowledge, that Mrs. ALAXA was residing with her daughter and son-in-law, IRINA and Dr. SCOTT ALAXE, at 1120 Fifth Avenue, New York City, as late as the week-end of June 30, 1951.</p>
