- 2. The following officers were elected provisionally:

Stan Ionescu -- Secretary General

- Some of the members of this organization are as follows: Nelu Manzaru; Virgil Constantinescu, former Consul General in Paris; Elerin Manoliu, former Commercial Attache; Francu; Grigore Manoilescu; Arnautu.
- 4. This organization has stated the following aims:
  - a. "The organization may be joined by any Rumanian, without distinction of sex, who has not been guilty of infamous acts and who is devoted to the ideas of liberty.
  - b. "The members of the group, whatever their political ideas and affiliations may be, mean te join hands for the sole purpose of fighting with all their might for the liberation of Rumania from the communist Soviet tyranny.
  - c. "The group intends to establish and maintain relations of collaboration with organizations of free Rumanians whose basic objectives and principles are similar."
- This new organization counts on the support of the Iron Guard and elements supporting General Radescu and is compesed mostly of Guardists.
- Reportedly, this organization has received financial aid from General Radescu.
