Collaboration of Busnos Aires Iron Quardist with Madescu's Organisation

Report by ____ from Buenos Aires, dated 5 November 1951:

"I have seen a letter addressed by Barby Riculescu to Stafan Tsoculescu, in which he tells him that Alexandru Matescu-Francu informed him of Tsoculescu's intention to make a donation to Radescu's group and expresses warm thanks. Barbu Miculescu further writes that Matescu-Francu is the empowered representative of the League and that the donation may be handed to him against receipt.

"As a matter of fact, I see from Radescu's newspaper 'Romanul' that the Dumos Aires Legionaries are making precious contributions to that paper. The last issue I received contained pasces by Kellu Mansatti, Vintila Horia, and Grigore Manoilescu (the latter writing under the pseudonym 'J. Carole Patagones').

"I emplained to Isoculesou the background of Radesou's group and of its branch set up here, and he promised he would contribute only one sum to it because he had promised to do so, but that he would give it no further support. Isoculesou is naive in all matters that are not business deals."

H. B. Barou Niculescu is General Radescu's secretary.

Alexandru Matesecu-Francu is a prominent member of the Iron Guard Group in Busnos Aires and editor of the Iron Guardist newspaper R*ANIA, published in Busnos Aires.

Kellu Mansatti and Origore Manoilescu belong to the same Iron Guard Group in Argentina. Vintila Horia is an Iron Guard sympathizer.

Stefan Tsoculescu is a wealthy businessman-a former friend of Archduchess Ileana, whe has no political affiliations.
