Report on Current Activities of Tanda CARAGRA BRAGADIRT MODVS

1. I cannot identify the individual in Zurich from whom Subject receives money regularly. I states that the almost monthly checks vary in amount between 2,000 and 5,000 Austrian Schillings. It might be a coincidence, but she usually receives the checks in Salzburg one or two days after she visits Kitzbuehel, in Austria.

Subject's permanent address in Salzburg is at 11 Faberstrasse.

- 2.
 A knows neither the purpose of Subject's frequent trips to Switzerland nor the kind of papers which she uses on such trips. Indexing by the fact that Subject had been married to a U.S. citisen, thought that she might be using U.S. papers.
- a. By the MALAXA group L Remans Nicolas MALAXA's circle of close friends both in the U.S. and abroad. He considers LORENIAN as belonging to this circle. In Rumania, LORENIAN, who was an "important businessman", worked closely with Nicolas MALAXA. This work consisted, on the one hand, of arranging business transactions, business deals and connections for MALAXA and, on the other hand, of acting as liaison man between MALAXA and the Iron Guard.
- b. The SIKA Iron Gmardists in Mestern Amstria and Germany who are unemployed or who are engaged in full time Iron Gmard work who amount to about half their total number are being paid monthly allowances by the Iron Gmard. This is done through Eircea DIMITRIU who, in addition to his other duties, is the Iron Gmard Treasurer for at least these areas. [] believes that at least part of these allowances are paid from funcs given to the Iron Gmard by MALAMA.
- 4. Subject is in contact with LOR*NIAN of the MALAXA group. She claims that she had been, before her divorce, a consin by marriage of LORENIAN's wife, the former Mrs. ORECEANU.

- 5. Overtly, the Iron Gnardists use injurious language whenever Subject's mame is mentioned and accuse her of being a Communist agent, of having betrayed them, etc. Covertly, however, Subject is on very good terms with a number of Iron Suzrdists and especially with Vasile MAILAT and Mircea DIMITAIN, both of whom she often meets.
- 6. One year ago, Subject was working for the same French IS which employed LV.Col. OFRAN. This was the reason why on her frequent visits to Innsbruck, Subject was quartered and ate her meals at Hotel Kreid, located at 3 Bozenerplatz. This hotel is requisitioned by the French Army and is used exclussively by French officers and their families.
- 7. On 15 December 1951, Mrs. Fire MANNA told C I in Manich that Subject had disappeared from Salzburg very suddenly. MANNA thought that Subject had left Salzburg for Italy approximately three weeks before the abovementioned date.

MANEA, who was hired recently by RFE in bunich, arrived in this city a short time ago from Salzburg. MANEA had been a secretary in the offices of the U.S. Military Representation, ACC for Rumania, in Ducharest.

- 8. Subject was Lt.Col. PRAN's agent in Austria for a long time, i.e. she contacted people, ran errands and handled papers and money which were sent by Ofran. Subject had given Capt. STOICANSCU his traval papers and money for his trip to Paris; Subject had contacted and had arranged the meetings between him and Ofran, every time that Ofran had wished to meet him. In thinks that recently Ofran severed his relations with Subject. Some indication of this is the fact that when In the was recently in faris, just before he left the city to return to Austria, Ofran gave him 6,500 fr. Fr. requesting him to change them into Austrian Schillings and pay the enough gam to kajor GROITORU lives in Salaburg and is acheduled to leave soon for the United States.

 Ofran explained to In that he was sending this money to CROITORU as a personal, private aid. According to In such transfers of money had been previously made by Ofran only through Subject.
- 9. LAMENIAN, who is of Armenian birth, has relatives in Switzerland degree of relation unknown where he travels often. He is also in contact with the French IS at Kitzbuehel, in Amstria.
