Appointment of the head of the Rumanian Tesk at Radio Free Europe in Munich.

Grigore Constantinescu, Representative of the Rumanian National Committee in London, reports on 31 December, 1952, that Mr. Allan Michie, head of Radio Free Europe's office in London, told a mutual friend that Rumanian broadcasts from Germany would be greatly intensified, beginning from next March, and that Mr. Viorel Tilea's appointment as head of the Rumanian desk of Radio Free Europe in Munich, was being considered.

(Mr. Viorel Tilea gave a statement in favor of Malaxa on 1 July, 1948. This statement is mentioned on pages 57-58, of the immigration report of 26 September, 1952. Mr. Mircea Grossu, 403, Glenallen Avenue, Youngstown, Ohio, could give evidence that he sent an important sum of Viorel and on behalf of Malaxa, in the summer of 1948).
