Maxim Maximo

Dan Dragomireson, whose testimony is quoted in the Dept. of Justice report concerning Malaxa, has stated that Malaxa had strong business connections with Maxim Maximo.

According to the attached clipping from IA SUISSE, of 16 March, 1952, Maximo has just lost the libel suit which he had started in Zurich against two persons who had accused him of being a communist agent.

It should be remembered that Malaxa was closely connected with Carlo Fleischman, who, together with Maximo, had set up in Smitzerland the "Offina" company, for exports to Eastern Europe. This company later passed under the control of the communist spy Solvan Vitzianu.

As for Fleischman's connections with Malaxa, evidence can be given by Ion Stanescu (and, perhaps, also by Remus Inla). The attached fotostatic copy of a letter from Carlo Fleischman to Gasten Boeuve, proves that Fleischman was President of the "Ofina." Evidence of Maximo's connections with the "Ofina" and of the accusition of that company by Vitzianu can be found in the records of the Vitzianu trial, which took place at Winterthur, in Switzerland, in June 1949. The matter is mentioned in the NEUE ZURCHER ZEITUNG of 18 June 1949.


