- Per Reference B, [redacted] Station has requested that we no longer send them the full intercepts on Max MERTEN. For this reason, and to expedite their transmission to MLB, we request that in the future you send all MERTEN intercepts directly to MLB. You need not send copies to COS, Germany.
- MLB: While [redacted] Station does not wish to receive the full intercepts they have requested receiving pertinent excerpts containing any information of particular interest to them. If in reviewing the intercepts you come across any such information, please send it on to [redacted].
- COS, [redacted]. In the most recent bunch of intercepts (covering the period 11 July to 3 August 1961), one concerned a resumé of a conversation between MERTEN and Mr. NIKOLOPOULOS on 31 July 1961. NIKOLOPOULOS asked MERTEN what was new and MERTEN replied that he had been so busy at the office that he hadn't had much time to bother with his own activities. He told NIKOLOPOULOS, however, that whenever the date for the Greek elections, which will take place early next year, is definitely decided upon, he would again become active. We are also forwarding an intercept from 25 July which may be of interest to you.
