ORGANIZATION OF UKRAINIAN
NATIONALISTS (OUN)
INTERNAL SECURITY - UKRAINE

NE T-1, who is in a position to furnish reliable information, advised that on November 1, 1964, Colonel Andrew Melnyk, who was chairman of the Executive Committee of the Organization of Ukrainian Nationalists (OUN), had succumbed to a long illness. NE T-1 said he learned that members of the Executive Committee of the OUN attended Melnyk's funeral held in Luxemburg, Germany.

Slave → NE T-1 said that from November 6 to 9, 1964, a special meeting of the Executive Committee of the OUN was held, at which time Deputy Chairman Shtul Zhdanovich, who is also editor of the newspaper "Ukrainian Worker", published at Paris, France, was elected to replace Melnyk as chairman of the Executive Committee of the OUN.

NE T-1 said he heard that members of the above Executive Committee will meet in November, 1965, to elect the leadership to reign for the next 7 years in accordance with their charter.

NE T-1 said that matters pertaining to the present policy of the OUN were also discussed at these meetings.
