MEMORANDUM FOR: THE RECORD

SUBJECT : MKULTRA Subproject 85

1. The purpose of Subproject 85 is to support the research of [redacted] of the Stanford University School of Medicine on human blood groups. [redacted] is one of the leading investigators on blood groups in man from both the immunological and genetic standpoints.

2. The scope of [redacted] study will include a literature survey on blood groupings from the forensic standpoint. He will also include in his survey the latest information available on the minor groupings. The attached proposal gives in detail the nature of the work to be done.

3. The total cost of the project for one year is estimated to be \$1,000.00. To this sum must be added \$40.00 representing a four percent service charge to the [redacted], making the total amount \$1,040.00. The [redacted] will function as cutout and cover for this grant. The cover title of the project is Human Blood Groups and is presumably being supported by a research grant from the [redacted] charges should be made against Allotment 9-2502-10-001. The project commences 1 July 1958.

4. The Foundation has requested [redacted] to submit a (summary) accounting of monies received and to return any unexpended grant funds
