MEMORANDUM FOR : THE RECORD
SUBJECT : MKULTRA, Subproject 109

1. The purpose of this subproject is to provide funds for the continuation of a study of potential psychopharmacological agents. In particular, studies will be directed to the elucidation of interrelationships between molecular constitution and biological response. Studies will be conducted into the biochemical characteristics of certain types of Chemical moieties which are of interest to TSD, [redacted] in carrying out its program on the development of means to control Human Behavior.

2. The attached Budget indicates the extent of the investigations that will be carried out under the direction of [redacted] [redacted] facilities available at the [redacted] the funds for this project will be transferred using the ~~Geschickter~~ ~~fund for Medical Research, Inc.~~ as a cutout.

3. The studies being carried out under this subproject were originally planned to cover a period of approximately five years based upon the attached proposal. However, the change in emphasis

of the present TSD program requires that these plans be altered considerably. The investigation has therefore agreed to produce as many actual end-item compounds as possible during the next year and also to consider this as the final year of the project. For this reason the attached budget has been scaled down from the original estimate of \$29,578.00 to \$21,080.00. The lower figure reflects mostly lowered personnel costs occasioned by the simpler developmental activities now planned.

4. The cost of this program for a period of one year will not exceed \$21,080.00 to which must be added the four per cent fee to the ~~Geschickter Fund~~ making the total amount \$21,923.20. Charges should be made against Allotment No. 3125-1390-3902.

5. The ~~Geschickter Fund~~ requires that the [redacted] submit to them a summary accounting on an annual basis of all monies received from the fund. Also, unexpended funds will be returned by the [redacted] as soon as possible upon the close of the grant year.

6. A requirement for a six months' informal accounting on the part of the principal investigator is waived.

7. It is not anticipated that any permanent equipment will be needed for this program.
