5. HITLER'S "Unner Circle". Plans for Future Existence.

HITLER Winner Circle": PW gives the following information on personalities older to HITLER:

- a. BORMANN, Martin: PW states that he (BORMANN) Torced his way
 between HITLER and practically everything except the SS and
 HIMINAT. He was a very enduring, virile person and a tremendous
 worker. As deputy for HESS he gradually took over the
 emiristration of the BERCHOF and thus came into bloser contact
 with HITLER personally. This position was much strengthened
 when shess left. HITLER showed him enormous confidence. BORMANN
 was very little known in GERMANY.
- wise very little known in CERMANY.

 5. BORMANN, Albert: He is a brother of Martin BORMANN. PW describes him as a quiet, decent person. He had the rank of NSKK GRUPPENFUEHRER and was adjutant to HITLER. He played no outstanding role, but tried to arbitrate whenever possible. HITLER considered him a good soul.
 - ALBRECHT: He had the title of NSKK BRIGADEFUEHRER. He was formerly a Navy adjutant and was chief of HITLER's Personnel Office (ADJUTANTUR) in BERLIN. Pw describes him as very objective and decent. HITLER definitely did not like him because he constantly tried to bring complaints, etc. before him. The Personnel Office was purely a personal agency of HITLER's and did not handle any SS material, as this went directly from HIMMLER to HITLER.
 - 1. BOUHLER: Chief of the Chicellery of the Fuencer. In the last few years, PW sites, BOUHLER, stood quite aside. He is described as endecent fellow.

- e. HOFFMANN, Heinrich: The Fuelier's Personal photographer. He was constantly close to HITLER and the two of them discussed art insequently and at great length.  - g. KEITEL: Pw believes HITLER must have valued KEITEL, because he kept him on to the end despite all the other changes. The connection is described as primarily official and not social.
 - h. BUHLE, General: He was a very comble officer, working a stoppy problems. HITLER thought highly of him.

JOUL: Ph beli was HITLER liked him very much.

- j. PUTTKAMER, Admiral von: Naval adjutant at HITLER's heudquarters.
 Very alert.
- k. ENGEL, General: He was Army adjutant at HITLER's HC, and entremely lively and alever person.
- 1. BELOW, Col. von: GAC adjutant at HITLER's Hu. The last three named were always present.
- m. There were four (4) female secretaries as follows:
 - i. Miss WOLF: PW states she is now in AUGSBURG PW Camp. In her middle forties, very capable and decent.
 - ii. Miss CHRISTIAN: She was the wife of Gen. CHRISTIAN, GAC General who was head of the GAC Operations Staff.
 - iii. Miss Christa SCHROEDER: An intelligent person, a quick, hard worker, who had been there for years.
 - iv. Mrs. JUNGE: Her husband had been valet to HITLER and then been killed in action. She had been active as secretary during the last year.
- n. LINGE: He was valet and succeeded JUNGE, though he had been there a long time too. He was an insignificant and dissatisfied person.
- 5. RATTENHUBER, OBERTJEHKER: He was the SD man who was chief of the KKIPO Section that protected HITLEK. This Section amounted to some 20 people in all. RATTENHUBER had held this job for 10-12 years at least. He was a typically active civil servant.
- p. HOEGEL, STANDARTENFULHRER: He was deputy to RATTENHUBER. Neither he nor RATTENHUBER ever did anything independently, but took orders from HITLER and HIMMLER.
- q. BAUR, OBERFUEHRER: He was chief pilot for HITLER's plane on most flights.
- r. BEETZ, OBLESTURMFUEHRER: Deputy to BAUR. RATTENHUBER, BAUR and BEETZ wore the uniform of the Field Police (FELDPOLIZEI).
- s. KE FAA: This was HITLER's chauffeur.

BRAUN, Eve: Pw states he knows her well, but he had seen her around HITLER's entourage for several years before he realized who and what she was. She never pushed herself into the foreground, but kept her place. She often tried to smooth things wer. There was nothing unusual about her looks. Pw believes HITLER was absolutely faithful to her.
