1. The attached document confirms information furnished you earlier by the undersigned that G-2 was transferring military personnel to Holabird. It appears to me that G-2, and to a lesser degree ONI, were very anxious to get rid of WDC since it would no longer be a going concern. (This is based on the belief that the military personnel assigned were the directing heads of the civilian group who have been protected in present employment by CIG action.)

2. I do not see any action to be taken by CIG. I believe it is up to G-2 to answer our basic request and indicate C/S approval or disapproval of the transfer of military personnel. If we do not get the military authorization, then I strongly recommend we acknowledge "the wool was pulled over our eyes" and not accept a defunct outfit.

3. What are your desires in the above?
