From Page 1 The completion dates for the (b)(1)first two reactors to be built by West Germany have already slipped a few years, and major construction problems will probably lead to further delays. (b)(1) (b)(3) The agreement commits Brazil only to the purchase of two power plants from West Germany. If serious balance-ofpayments deficits persist, it will be difficult for future administrations to justify the purchase of the additional six reactors originally contemplated. (b)(3)
