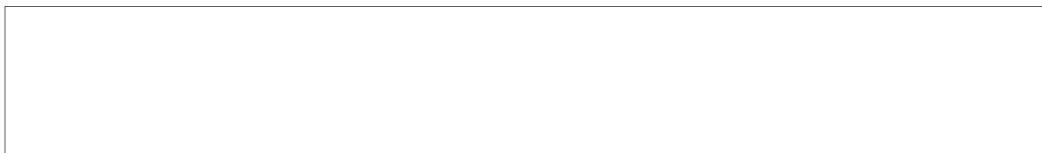

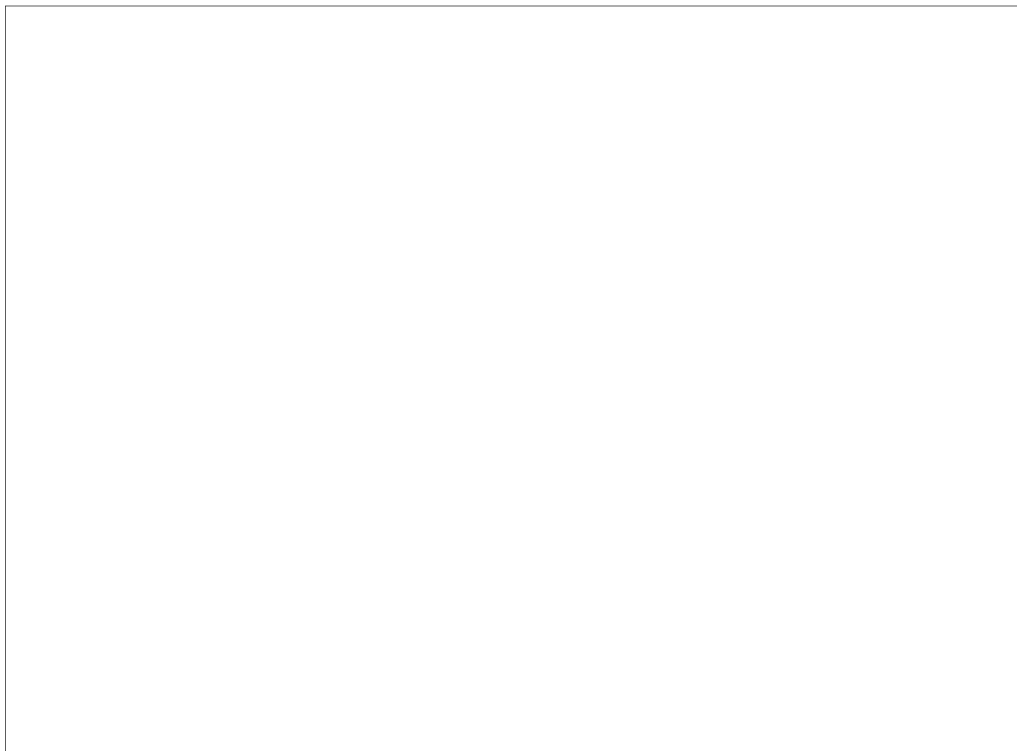

EL SALVADOR: Army Operations Renewed

The Army has resumed offensive operations as part of its plan to maintain security during the runoff election scheduled for late April or early May. [Redacted]

The [Redacted] reports that elements of the elite Beloso Battalion have joined other government units in central San Vicente Department to attack guerrilla forces. He says the airborne battalion has moved into northwestern San Miguel Department to act as a blocking force for other units moving in from the east and the southeast. [Redacted]
