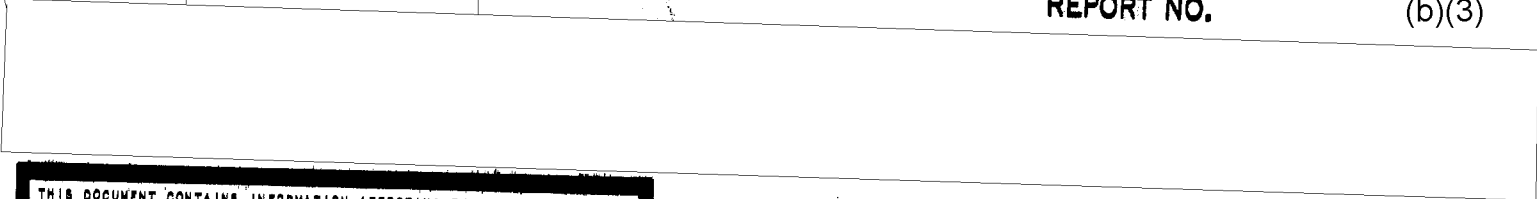

1. Between 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. on 6 October 1952, elements of the 1 and 2 Battalions of Nationalist guerrillas raided Nanchen (120-26, 27-08). One company struck immediately west of Nanchen and two companies hit the eastern tip of the peninsula.
2. The guerrillas engaged one Communist platoon, killing forty men, and capturing four regular army men and seven militiamen. Five guerrilla raiders were killed and four wounded.
3. During the raid, the Nationalist ships YALUNG (7161/7893) and KAOAN (7559/1344) and the guerrilla gunboats YUYUEH (3342/4727), BLUE ANGEL, SHENGAN (0524/1344) and IAN (5030/1344) shelled the mainland for three hours.
