- 1. Between 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. on 6 October 1952, elements of the 1 and 2 Battalions of Nationalist guerrillas raided Nanchen (120-26, 27-08). One company peninsula.
- 2. The guerrillas engaged one Communist platoon, killing forty men, and capturing four regular army men and seven militiamen. Five guerrilla raiders were killed and four wounded.
- 3. During the raid, the Nationalist ships YALUNG (7161/7893) and KAOAN (7559/1344) and the guerrilla gunboats YUYUEH (3342/4727), BLUE ANGEL, SHENGAN (0524/1344) and IAN (5030/1344) shelled the mainland for three hours.
