- 7. It should be noted that <u>NEW</u> claims to have the woral and, to a slight extent, anterial support of Allied authorities, although he does not specify whether these are American, French, or British.

- 9. NET, contained as one of this organizations promoters, is identified as a descendent of Marshal NEY of the Mupolechic era. He is quoted as stating, during his visit to "Lian and Rorse, that the sovement is founded with the knowledge and support of Amorican authorities and that it has been also supported by the well-known German, LAUTERRACH, organizer of the German Youth which was afterwards transformed into the HITLERINGEND.

ATTACHEENT A (translation)

DECLARATION

Rome - Christmas 1948

- 1. To Mr. Luigi SOLOGIVARY, the undersigned, Dr. Carlo NEY declares under his full responsibility, that he belonged only to the political party denominated the "Party of Hungarian konovation", under the direction of Bela HIREDY.
- 2. In 1942, I left this party to create the "Appociation of Comrades of the Eastern Front Lines" the political purposes of which were unequivocably Hungarian and national. The group was formed with the authority of the "inistry of Interior. The Association of Comrades of the Fastern Front Lines, whose initials were KABS2, was never at the dependence of any party. The total number of its members throughout the country exceeded 120,000. "Members included reserve officers and war veterans, as well as civilians ready to take up arms on behalf of their country.
- 3. After 15 October 1944, <u>Preserved</u> SZALASST attempted to discolve the KABSZ and to consider it as the armed civilian formation of the Arrow Cross Party. In the face of this, I immediately discolved the KABSZ. SZALASST then dismissed me from the Corps of officers and deprived me of my Hungarian citizenship.
- . After 15 October 1944, the Hungarian territorial defense was in complete dissolution and the country and its cities became an easy pray to the Russian attacks. Seeing this and being conscious of my duty as an Hungarian patriot, I established an independent military group in which I gathered all who presented themselves who had not other military obligation. I maked the group Hungarian Assault Rangers. It had the purpose of permitting the retirement of the military elements which remained in Testorn Hungary.
- 5. As not even the most elementary necessities had been provided for (such as arms, supplies, hospital facilities, etc.) and lacking during the month of January, heavy uniforms and arms, on 25 January 1945, I joined the German SS under the title of "Kampf Grupp <u>NET</u>". By formation was entirely Hungarian and according to the written understandings, agreed upon with the "affen SS, the unit was assured Hungarian contand and leadership. German contanders were placed only on the Division level.
- 6. I declare finally that neither I nor any member of my formation ever committed terroristic acts against civilian populations, sacking or racial persecution. In support of this, I cite the fact that an Allied judicial proceeding against me which lasted almost two years was concluded with my complete absolvement.
- 7. I declare that I have no intention of taking part in any political movement either now or in the future, and I will do anything in my power to eliminate anything that will disturb Humarian emigration in order to partit the achievement of the common goal. I an disposed to participate with arms at any time in the struggle. for the liberation of Hungary and to come to agreement with Dr. Tiberio 2000 MARDY by means of personal accords for conducting unified military operations.

- The persons above named have called 'r. Luigi SCOTVARY to preside 1. over the discussions.
- :r. LAUT. ABACHLN explains that, according to the opinion of allied 2. military commands in Germany and to the opinion of German generals who, at present time enjoy complete liberty after having been cleared of every accusation, because of its present unpreparedness military action only for a few months and partups only for a few wasks. Excepted from this judgment are the few countries which are relatively better organized and which, for geographical positions, find themselves in a more favorable situation, i.e. Saitserland, Spain, the Alpine regions, and Borthern Italy.
- In the event of a future Mussian invasion, the regular military 3. formations would be destroyed, losing thoreby all offensive possibilities as a result of the battle sustained and ac the result of the offset of Communist 5th Columns. A very important part, there-fore, develves upon the national civilian volunteer formations which would function at the back of the Russian army (partisan, guarilla warfare). Their function, above all, would consist of custinuous disturbance of Russian lines of communication and supply, forcing the enamy to sustain a continuin; battle behind the front. Applying these civilian military groups would be left to the motions opposed to the Bussians.
- On the basis of the above considerations, Ir. LANT. DBACHER has had h. the task of bringing about with every security procention, preparations in the Western German zone for the par bou of organizing Gorman youth, making con act with similar poverients in the Bultic States, so that in the event of war collaboration could be assured of the national resistance organizations of the Finns, Lithuaniano, Estonians, Manos, Fredes, and Morrogians, as well as the Penelux powers. Simultaneously, Carlo NEY ando contact with the chiefs of the anti-Rolshev_k avagent in the countries of Lastern Surope i.e. with the milikary resistance groups which are being organized in Poland, Rungary, ...estern Ukraine, Kurania, Vugoalavia, and Austrin.

The collaboration between <u>Dr. NEY</u> and <u>Tr. LAUTERBATHER</u> began in July 1948 and both are in continuous personal relations with the interested German and Austrian military elements, as well as with those of other states. Innamuch as in the event of war "setern Europe would not be able to become the center of an anti-Bolshevik organization and, on the other hand, Southern Italy would be one of the most important and most defended Allied bases, both military and spiritual, it is necessary that the spiritual center of this intermational anti-Bolshevik resistance be established in Italy. This Italian spiritual center would also be well chosen from the point of international communications, with the Arab world, but above all for overseas supplying from the United States and England. The anti-Bolshevik international organization intends to create in Italy on¹ a spiritual center under the direction of and in strict collaboration with compstent Italian military authorities. At the same time it will international constant relations with the secret and overt Italian anti-Bolshevik organizations.

- The International anti-Bolshevik organization, hereafter called NAESZ, will carry out the following activity before the initiation of hostilities:
 - a) Uncover Bolshevik activities and plans in the military, political, and economic fields in all of the occupied countries from Finland to Greeco;
 - b) Uncover Mussian activity and plane in the military, political and economic fields in the non-occupied countries of "estern Europe, and the Arab States;
 - c) Uncover the political activities of various "ruopean exigration groups, as well as Bolshevik agents the are attempting to subtage and liquidate these groups. Thus, the MAESZ will furnish information and exact mames to the Italian military and civilian organizations with which it collaborates, of t occ persons who are sent to Italy to carry out undermining, disintegrative activity for "olshevik paryoses. Among other things, Bolsheism is carrying cut a major propagenda effort in territories of Youth Azerican States. For this purpose it sends thousands of agents via Italy. It is necessary absolutely to uncover these agents and advise the Italian authorities of their identities.
 - 6) Maintain the strictest collaboration and constant relations between the military organizations of the MAES' and the Italian General Staff.
 - e) In the event of an internal revolution brought about by the Communists, the NAES2 mill place at the disposition of Italian military communis its international anti-Bolshavik military groups both for open and for guerille warfare.
 - f) Besides the above indicated activity, and related to it, one of the principal functions of the MANSE will be that of expanding the mumber of its members by means of organization and propaganda and to create against the Cominform an anti-Cominform organization which will be active and militant, covering the entire world.
 - g) At the present moment, the NAESZ disposes of the following possibilities:

- Complete and sup ort and, in the event of necessity, the material support of the anti-Solshevik civilian population numbering several millions of individuals in estern Surope and in the countries occupied by the Russians;
- ii) The moral support, and in a small measure, the material support of Allied Anglo-Sacon authorities which, however, in the event of necessity, will adapt themselves to the needs of the moment;
- 111) The NAESZ at the moment numbers about 100,000 active members ready for the struggle disposed of any time to risk their lives in action against the Bolsheviks. Among the Hungarian emigrees, there are about 5,000 and in Hungary about 15.000, organized in the A.M.A.
- 7. The organization of Italian centers of the MAES, will be possible in the following manner:

The MAIST center, as a secret mi itary organization, will carry out its activity within the framework of a perfectly disguised connercial activity. Contemporaneously, it would have to attempt to assure itself the funds necessary to cover expenses of operations by conducting import and export operations which would be made possible by the Italian organizations. This conversion enterprize should be Italian and, therefore, that makes it necessary that the interosted Italian authorities designate a pe son of their trust to be the head of the organization. The MAEST does not ask for any enterial support from the Italian State. It asks only that its activity be made possible and in addition that the persons composing its directorate, makering in all about 14, be given the possibility of free entrance and exit from the country.



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
