Admirel (retired)

Grac. Naval Acadea, in 1898; served in Austria and Germany; later in the U.I. and at the Paris Peace Conference; became an admiral in 1925; in 177, he was commander in chief of the pro Fleet, at the time of the First Shanghat war. Lost one eye in the attempt on his like at a parade after the conclusion of peace. 1970: Succeeded Saite a. Ambassador to the U.C., and was in machabington in December 1941, with special envoy

Kurusu, talking "peace", when Japan attacked Pearl Harbor. Was interned on Dec.8,1941, and was in the U.S. until the summer of 1942, when Japanese internees were exchanged for Americans in the Par East. <u>Bept.21.1942</u> Reported to have arrived in Istanbul, Turkey, together with Admiral Abe, on his way to Berlin as Haval Attaché, (while Abe is going to Rome as Baval Attaché).

M.MURA, Kichassaburo

May 27, 1943; Jap Broadcast from Batavia to the U.S. carried declaration by Romura that the U.S. war effort would not be a long one. (indication that Nomura is in Java ?)
