I MOMERA believes Japan is indebted to CHIAM for (a) his hamme and indulgent attitude toward the Japanese after World War II, and (b) his preservation of the Emperor. At the Cairo Conference CHIAM was the man responsible for the Big Four agreement to retain the Japanese Emperor on the throne. After he met CHIAMS on Taiwan, ROMERA was completely won over by the Chinese Nationalist leader who replied that he deserved so thanks since he had surely noted in an homorable and humans manner. honorable and humans manner.
