1. Reference is made to the request dated 14 January 1968, subject as above, whose name you desired checked against the files of this office. Subject is well known to this office as the chief Japanese negotiator immediately prior to the Japanese attack on Pearl Harbor in December 1941. After World War II, he wrote the book, My Mission to the United States, which reminisced his unsuccessful efforts to prevent the War. He is also well known for his activities in post-war Japan in political and military fields. For background and biographic data on Subject, you are referred to [ ] Registry, Office of Central Reference.

2. The [ ] has no record of a current operational interest in Subject. However, due to Subject's position, he maintains contact with several members of the official United States community. If covert use of Subject is contemplated, full coordination must be effected in the field.
