Brief Description of Project and Notes----

I. OBJECTIVE

The objective of Project OBHUNT is the infiltration of agent teams into Albania for the purposes of establishing resistance nets, E & E nets, W/T nets; dead drops for the collection of operations and PW intelligence, spreading the name of the National Committee for a Free Albania (which is used as the ostensible sponsor of these teams - see project HTNEIGH) and assessing the effectiveness of the CIA FW effort mounted in the name of the NOFA. The ultimate objective of the project is for these teams to provide the nucleus of a striking and guiding force for armed resistance by the populace against the incumbent communist regime at the proper time.

II. ASSETS

- A. The major asset of the project is the agent pool of approximately 25 trained Albanians which is maintained in the Athens area.
- B. The Lavrion DP camp in Greece can be considered a project asset to the extent that promising agent material appears there from time to time as new refugees arrive.
- C. A negligible asset is the Albanian Guard Company (h000th Labor Service (Guard) Bettalion) located in Hohenbrunn, Germany and now controlled by EUCOM. The personnel of this unit would be available to CIA in the event of a need for a striking force to implement active UW against the communist regime.

III. OPERATIONAL DEVELOPMENTS SUPPORTING OBJECTIVE

Since 11 November 1950 when the first agents were air-dropped into Albania OBHUNT and its predecessor parent Project BGFIEND have had the following results:

The first year of operations was marked by the use of low level agents recruited from the Guard Company and a lack of security on the part of witting NCFA members. As the result of the 1951 record of h agents captured and 9 killed, training and recruiting of agents in Germany with the knowledge of the NCFA was cancelled. The success of this move was reflected in the fact that there were no losses of any kind during the agent operations season of 1952. Agents have produced a considerable amount of PW and operations intelligence, have contacted numerous friends, established dead letter drops for future operations use, have confirmed that the CHA PW effort against Albania (Projects HTGRUBBY and OBTUSE) is reaching its mark and have generally helped to instill the ideas of passive resistance and the hope for ultimate liberation in the minds of the populace.

IV. NEGATIVE DEVELOPMENTS

The major negative developments in Project OBHUNT have been the loss of 18 agents through capture, death, and defection plus the possible loss of 12 others. Also to be considered are the increased security controls within the country and the intensification of security patrols.
