

King Zog expressed himself as strongly in favor of the formation of a united Front of all anti-communisist Albanian exiles. He agreed that the question of the future regime should be left to the free choice of the Albanian people. King Zog accepted that Frasheri should be the

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MEMORANDUM OF CONVERSATION WITH KING ZOG I ON MAY 5 1949.

A meeting was held with King Zog I at Alexandria Egypt on May the 5th I949. It was explained that the United States would look with favor upon the formation of a united front of all anti Communist Albanians abroad. It was pointed out that refugees from certain other Sovietdomitnated countries, such as Bulgaria and Hungary, had achieved a degree of unity that enabled their leaders to be accorded the moral right to be considered the spokesmaen for their peoples. It is hoped that the Albanians abroad would be similarly successful.

King Zog was informed, that Midhat Frasheri had declared that he favored the formation of such a united front and would work actively towards this end. The hope was expressed, that Zog I would adopt a similar attitude. It was pointed out that King Zog could greatly assist in this work by endorsing the proposed front and be encouraging his followers to participate. Furthermore, it was felt that King Zog dould make a most significant contribution to the unity of Albanians abroad by issuing a public decalration stating that he welcomed a united front under the chaffmanship of Frasheri, that the question of the fubure regime of Albania would be left in abeyance pending a free plebicsite by the Albanian people, and in the meantime the royal prerogatives should be considered suspended.

King Zog was informed of the American opinion that Midhat Frasheri should be the leader of the united front and that his group should form the nucleous of the movement. It was the hope of the United States Government that Kind Zog would wholeheartedly support this proposal the sole object of which is the establishment of a united front by Albanians abroad.

King Zog expressed himself as strongly in favor of the formation of a united Front of all anti-communisist Albanian exiles. He agreed that the question of the future regime should be left to the free choice of the Albanian people. King Zog accepted that Frasheri should be the

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leader of the united front and stated that he would support the movement He felt that Frasheri should secure as associated a person of the legitimist party as well as a person of merit from the Independant party, so that the comitee should have 2 moslems, one orthodox and one Roman catholic. King Zog stated that he could not declare his royal prerogatives in suspense as this would be unwise as well as dislogal to his pledge to the Albanian people. Such action, he said would jeopardize the continued recognition of Albanian anti Communist / royalist/ diplo matic missions in Egypt, Turkey and elsewhere. More fundametally, he felt that such action would be equivalent to laying aside the duty which the the italian faciste occupati Albanian National Assembly had placed upon him before his-flight. He stated that the Assembly had upon that occasion charged him to represent the nation abroad until its liberation. He recommends for the sake of the movement that Frasheri should visit Egypt, Syria Turkey, Italy Greece and whereever there were significant groups of Albanian exiles , talk to them , secure from them written declarations of support, and thus become recognised as the leader of the united front . King Zog volunteered to help in the foregoing and to make a public declaration along the desired lines when it was considered useful.

King Zog expressed himself strongly on the importance that Midhat Frasheri should come to Egypt and receive from His lisps the assurance of His help.

J,accueille avec une grande satisfaction la formation de "United Front Albanais, comme le moyen d,aboutir a l,unité parmi les Albanais se trouvant àl, Etranger, et aussi pour apporter un réconfort moral aux Albanais se trouvant dans leur pays, qui est maintnant sens la domination d,un gouvernement communiste d,obédience etrangère.

Je donnerai avec toutes me forces , mon appui à l'unitéd Front Albanais et à son comité. Je pousserai tous les Albanais afin qu'ils donnent leur adhésion à ce mouvement , dont le but est la recouvrement de l'independance Albanaise dans toute son integrité.

J,ai dèclarè publiquement en I940, I946, et successivement à plusieurs reprises, que le futur règime de l,Albanie sera laissélentierement au grè du peuple Albanais, le quel le cas dehéapour échéant poura faire connaître ses aspirations au moyen d,un libre plebiscite apres la libèration du pays.

Je considère cette mèthode comme ètant entierement compabible aux pricipes democratiques.

Je dèclare n, exercer aucune de mes prèrogatives royales à l, encontre de "United Front Albanais " àl, encontre de ses activités ou de son comité preside par Midhat Frsheri, sous condition toutefois, qu, elles n, aillent pas a l, encontre des aspirations de la Nation Albanaise et qu, elles n, aient pour but le recouvrement de l, independance albanaise et l, integrité de son territoire.

Cette presente declaration en ce qui conserne les lignes génerales sera publiée le jour ou les differentés parties mentionnées dans notre premier entretien auront procede à la composition du comité de le "united Front Albanais.

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A la suite du procès verbal relatant l,entretien que j,ai eu avec Monsieur Berry en prèsence de Monsieur Miner le 5 Mai 1949, et après la declaration que j,ai signée le 14 Juin 1949, je tiens à y adjoindre un additif faisant partie intègrante de ma declaration et qui peut se resumer en trois points.:

I/ Etant donné que je représente la légitimité et la legalité je serai désireux que toutes les questions revêteant un interêt primordial soient portèss à ma connaissance aux fins de consultation par le comité directeur de le "United Front Albanais " en pleiene collaboration, et si cela s,avère nèdessaire par l,entremise des autorités americaines compêtentes.

2/ Conformement aux princeipes de légitimité et de légalité sus mentionnes et etant investi constitutionellement, je chargerai un gouvernement à tendance totalement neutre, durant la période transitoire qui suivra la libération de l, Albanie, d, organiser les opérations preliminaires qu, exig era le plebiscite, et si cela est utile sous le contrôle interallié.

J, ai sanctione le choix de Midhat Frasheri en tant que President de Comité directeur de "United Front Albanais" en raison de l,entière confiance que j,ai en son patriotisme, mais au cas ou Midhat Frasheri demissionerait ou pour toute autre raison imprevisible je devrais être consulté sur le choix de son éventuel remplacant et egalement sur la formant on du comité directeur si celle ci venait à être modifieé.
